We then paid the 1st hotel our arrange price and found out they were paying the USPS team the \$200/ night difference that the new hotel was costing and left. We can't be sure but it appeared USPS wanted to change hotels and we were "cancelled". When we arrived at the new hotel we saw immediately why USPS couldn't stay there. It had an underground garage and they could not get their bus or vehicles in it.



It turned out our hotel was the hotel being occupied by the UCI and TdF officials, so there were official cars everywhere so like many other people we took turns taking our pictures with the #1 car which was JeanMarie LeBlanc's car. We were also able to get pictures with team cars since they were all there at various times checking in and for official pre race meetings. Our window overlooked the 1 km kite and was a great place to hang the American Flag and our "Go Levi" sign we made when we realized what a great place we had ended up with.

We enjoyed watching Steven Cozza at the World's in Canada in 2003 and hope to eventually watch one of the Swifts at the Tour.
