Team Swift Shows Support for the Vineman Triathlon August 1, 2004 Sonoma County, CA

Event Description

Team Swift supported the final feed zone for the triathletes finishing the 56 mile bike section of the Vineman Half Ironman Triathlon on August 1, 2004 in Sonoma Country, California. After completing a 1.2 mile swim, a 56 mile bike ride and then a 13.1 mile run two winners emerged.

England's Matt Dixon and Kristianna Gough from San Leandro, California were crowned champions of the 14th edition of the Vineman Half Ironman Triathlon. The biggest prize awaiting athletes on the day, other than some fine wine from La Crema, was one of 30 qualifying spots to the Ironman World Championships in Hawaii.

Beginning the day, 1800 athletes gathered at the start in Guerneville under chilly, but perfect, race conditions in Sonoma County California. A day that started with fog cover, cool temperatures (both water and air) later gave way to beautiful blue skies and a high temperature of only 75 degree's.
